NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
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NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **April 6, 2021 at 7:00 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CITIZEN ADVISORY (HCDA) COMMITTEE will hold a public hearing on the City of Alhambra's proposed 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan, to receive comment pursuant to and in compliance with the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) pre-submission requirements. **PLEASE NOTE:** Consistent with Executive Orders No. N-29-20 and No. N-35-20 from the Executive Department of the State of California and the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health Safer At Home Order, the HCDA Committee meeting will not be physically open to the public, although the public may participate via teleconference or video, and Committee Members may choose to participate via teleconference or video rather than in person. The HCDA Committee will be providing an overview of the programs the City will continue to offer throughout the next fiscal year. These programs include:

- Public Services
- Public Facilities & Capital Improvements
- CDBG Administration
- HOME Administration
- Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDO)
- Home Buyer Program

All members of the community are invited to attend via teleconference or video. The City of Alhambra welcomes the participation of Alhambra citizens in the development of the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan. This plan has been prepared in advance of the City receiving its final funding allocation from HUD, the budget figures will be adjusted upon receipt of our allocation.

Any person wishing to be heard on this matter is invited to attend this public hearing and speak to the HCDA Committee at the time and place stated. Pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 2117, no action or proceeding may be brought in court unless that alleged grounds for noncompliance with the California Environmental Quality Act were presented to the HCDA Committee orally or in writing by any person, and no person shall maintain an action or proceeding unless that person objected to the approval of the Project orally or in writing to the HCDA Committee.
