For those wishing to speak on an agenda or non-agendized item, you have **3 options** for participation:

**1) Pre-register to speak:** Please email Vincent Hon at [vhon@cityofalhambra.org](mailto:vhon@cityofalhambra.org) by 5:00 p.m. prior to the meeting with the **item number you wish to speak on and the phone number you will use when calling or the name you will use when logging into the meeting**. You should then call or log into the meeting at least 10 minutes prior to its start time. Staff will unmute you and announce you when it is your time to speak. You will have five minutes to speak, unless that time is adjusted by the Recreation Supervisor. If you do not have access to a computer, please call 626-570-3297 to request public comment.

**2) “Raise your hand”:** For those members of the public that wish to speak but did not make a request via email as described above, such members of the public may speak by using the “Raise Hand” function during the public comments portion, if on Zoom. Staff will unmute you and announce you when it is your time to speak. If participating via telephone, the Mayor will ask anyone participating by telephone if they would like to speak after asking those on Zoom. Staff will unmute telephone callers and you may state you wish to speak.

**3) Emailed comments to be read into the record:** As an alternative to speaking during the meeting, you can email your comments to the Recreation Supervisor at [vhon@cityofalhambra.org](mailto:vhon@cityofalhambra.org) **by no later than 5:00 p.m.** on November 9, 2021 to ensure that the Recreation Supervisor has time to print the emails prior to the beginning of the meeting. Comments will then be read into the record by the Recreation Supervisor, with a maximum allowance of 5 minutes per individual comment, subject to the Recreation Supervisor’s discretion. If a comment is received after 5:00 p.m. but before the conclusion of the meeting based upon its time stamp, the comment will still be included as a part of the record of the meeting but will not be read into the record.
